<u>Staff Shortages:</u> In a May issue of the Bay of Plenty Times it was reported that schools in the Bay were suffering from dire teacher shortages and that Principals were having to employ staff without a teaching qualification. This is already a nationwide problem. Towards the end of this term we have been hit with a lot of staff sickness and we have found it increasingly more difficult to get relievers. When we have no other option, we will split classes to accommodate our tamariki in other rooms within their team, if no reliever is available.
